## PhD student position in agricultural economics

## Labor management and decision to implement alternative practices to pesticides in livestock farms

The SMART LERECO unit is seeking a PhD student for a three year scholarship.

The unit includes researchers from the French national institute of agricultural research (INRAe) and lecturers from the agricultural university Institut Agro- Agrocampus Ouest. SMART LERECO's main research interests relate to the analysis and evaluation of public policies in the fields of agriculture, food industry and environment. The candidate will conduct research in the field of **agricultural production economics**. The aim is to conceive and implement microeconomic models and discrete choice experiments to test different levers of getting out pesticides in livestock farms with alternative practices. Labor is a huge lever for innovation and has been little investigated in agricultural economics (because of lack of data and difficulties to assess its quality and quantity in farms), until know. The modelling and experiments will aim at increasing knowledge on and overcome the barriers to the transition to pesticide-free agriculture and to figure out the possible consequences (on environmental, productive and market aspects) of these changes. This work will help to design new instruments to guide private and public intervention at play in transition for agroecological farming in France.

The PhD will start on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.
